


## Changes in English Placement Distribution

### Academic Year 2018-2019 Target English Courses Success Rates by HS GPA Range

#### **Purpose and Limitations**

In compliance with AB705 requirements, the English department has adopted and implemented the default placement rules recommended by the Multiple Measures Assessment Project (MMAP) using mainly the high school overall GPA threshold for placement into English writing courses since summer 2018. For local validation purpose, this research brief provides a preliminary view on target English course success rates by high school GPA within the academic year of 2018-2019 without considering other factors or the interaction of multiple factors. One needs to take caution in interpreting success rates based on small numbers (<30) because such rates (being grayed out below) are not reliable to use for comparison. It should also be noted that success rates of courses with very few sections offered are more likely to be influenced by faculty's grading practices.
