

Fall and Winter Sports Update—November 25, 2019

Fall Sports

- Cross Country Men - SCC Conference Champs, placed 2nd in the South and will compete for a State Title next weekend.
- Cross Country Women - 2nd in conference, finished 4th in the South and will also be competing for a State Title.
- Football - National Central Conference Champs and will earn a #3 Seed in the State Playoffs, most likely traveling to Canyons this weekend
- Golf, Women - 2nd in conference, top individual golfer, placed 5th in South missing State by 4 strokes. Qualified 3 golfers to State Tournament.
- Soccer, Men - Conference Champs, Conference Tournament Champs, Undefeated season and currently ranked #1 in the Country, # 1 in the State and will be top seed in the playoffs.
- Soccer, Women - 4th in conference, will earn a playoff seed for first time in 3 years.
- Volleyball, Women - 5th in conference, playing in consolation championship in conference tournament.
- Water polo, Men - 2nd in conference, was ranked 4th in the State, 3rd in So Cal, lost in the quarterfinals of playoffs.
- Water polo, Women - 3rd in conference, missed playoff opportunity
- Wrestling, Men - 2nd in conference, currently ranked 3rd in the State.

Winter - Early in the Season

- Basketball, Men - Playing in tournaments, tough preseason schedule, currently 2-5 on neutral courts.
- Basketball, Women - Mountie Classic Tournament Champs, currently ranked #4 in the South, 3-1 on the season, only loss to #1 ranked team.
