DREAMERS

7 local high school students were awarded the **Dream.US scholarship** for **\$14,500/year** to attend Mt. SAC.

1 was awarded a \$29,000/year transfer scholarship.

\$124,000 was raised by Mt. SAC faculty, administrators, staff and students to support students' **DACA renewal fees.**

Bridge Program

Incoming freshmen in the Summer Bridge Program have a

▶ 98% retention rate

> 90% pass rate average

Students enrolled in the fall and spring Bridge Program have higher pass rates in English 1A (72%) and Math 71 – Intermediate Algebra (62%) than non-Bridge students.

High School Outreach

Of the **1,691** high school students who applied for Fall 2018 through the **Connect 4** program:

> 99% completed an assessment

▶ 91% enrolled in classes

> 98% completed an abbreviated education plan

► 61% enrolled full-time

Conversely, only 25% of non-Connect 4 applicants registered in classes, with only 42% enrolling full-time.
