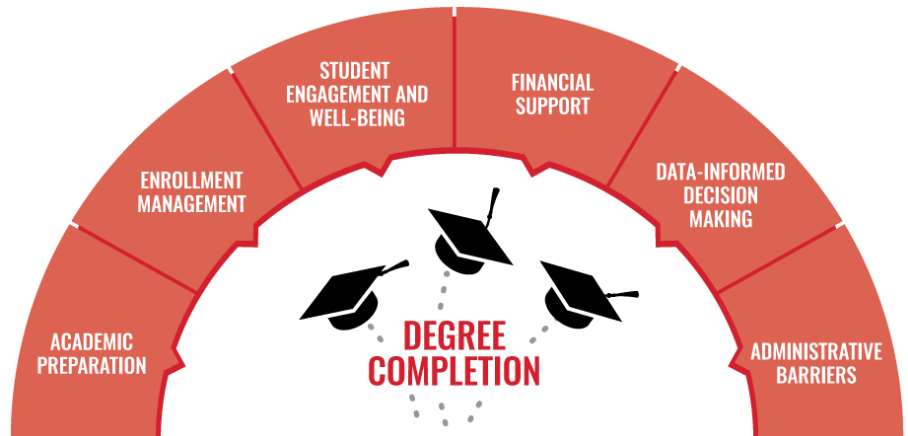


How We're Implementing Change
