

Legislative Action Floor Update
September 12, 2019

Hi Team! We are down to two days left of session (whew), and tackling some big policy proposals. End of session for us is all about the education facilities bond! As I mentioned, with the late amendments, the bill isn't even eligible to be taken up until tomorrow evening. I wanted to provide you with an update on bills we care about.

- AB 30 (Holden): Community colleges: College and Career Access Pathways partnerships. – Support. Passed to the Governor.
- AB 48 (O'Donnell): Education finance: school facilities: Kindergarten-Community Colleges Public Education Facilities Bond Acts of 2020 and 2022. – Support. Will be taken up by the Senate and Assembly tomorrow evening.
- AB 302 (Berman): Parking: homeless students. – Oppose. Pulled by the Author.
- AB 612 (Weber): CalFresh: Restaurant Meals Program. – Support. Passed to the Governor.
- AB 1727 (Weber): Community colleges: career development and college preparation courses. – Support. On the Senate Floor.
- SB 554 (Roth): Public schools: adult school students: Advanced Scholastic and Vocational Training Program. – Support. Passed to the Governor.

We have and will continue to prepare letters to the Governor requesting his action. Please let me know if you have any questions. Thanks...Ashley
