Purpose:

The Mapping & Catalog Committee is responsible for ensuring that the online catalog clearly articulates course sequences for students, identifies critical progress milestones to ensure student success, and makes this information easily accessible on the college's website. The committee will work together to address gaps relating to online navigation of Mt. SAC programs from entry to completion. The committee will review and interpret legislative and Chancellor's Office initiatives relating to program guidance, use of and rights under the College catalog and functionality addressed and communicated for faculty, staff, and students.

Function:

- 1. To make recommendations for the development and timely maintenance of program maps and program data in the catalog and on department websites
- 2. Systematically review current, develop, and recommend policies and procedures to support accurate, consistent, and timely mapping and catalog publication
- 3. Ensure that online access to maps and College catalog, including that the content is developed to be relevant and appropriate for Mt. SAC student users
- 4. Evaluate functionality of online catalog for use by students and faculty
- 5. Support policies and procedures to ensure accuracy and relevancy of information provided on the college's website on the employment and further education opportunities targeted by each program.
- 6. Support the coordination of communication with students regarding onboarding, registration, and notifications.
- 7. Ensuring alignment of necessary timelines for publication and release, as well as clarity on effective dates for changes to policies
