1. Ellucian - True-Up Licenses and Maintenance for Oracle	Each year the College is required to certify FTE students and staff to Ellucian to verify Oracle license counts based on MIS data. The College was licensed for 34,646 Oracle Users as of the 2010-11 fiscal year. Over the last eight years, the count has fluctuated but never gone above 34,646 until now. The most recent MIS data available via the Chancellor's Office datamart is for 2017-18 and indicates the College is now at 35,309.8 FTE staff and student. This is an increase of 664 users which requires a true-up of licenses. The one-time cost is \$178,976 for the additional licenses.
