Here is where we currently stand with the voting center request...

The group has identified both 6-160 and 9C as suitable locations. They would like to use 6-160 in the fall this year for a "mock election" and both locations in March and November of 2020 for regular elections. I believe the voting runs for 12 days, with a day on the front and back for setup/takedown. Our office is working to get these dates blocked out ASAP and to relocate anyone who currently has reservations in those spaces. This will be a major outage of our event spaces on campus for an extended period of time. I just want to make sure that your office is aware of this and supportive of it.

Several weeks ago I spoke with a gentleman named Andre from the voting organization. It seemed like he was interested in getting our cooperation to be a host site. I told him we were on board with it, we just needed his logistics team to approve the locations, which is sounds like we not have confirmation of.

I have Jim Friesen working on pulling together what our hard costs might be for this. Typically we just unlock and lock the room for the group, but with this new voting format, I'm not sure if they have additional expectations of us.



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
