

Vaccine Logistics Subgroup Update – January 22, 2021

- Health Services and Event Services worked together to determine an ideal location for the vaccination clinic. The building 66 & 67 courtyard was determined to be a suitable location for traffic flow, parking, and proximity to the Student Health Center in building 67A.
 - The subgroup concurred with the location selection.
- Additional guidance was provided by the LACDPH. Mt. SAC will be classified as a Closed Medical Point of Dispensing.
 - A Closed MPOD is defined by the County as *a facility that is used temporarily during public health emergencies to dispense preventive medication to a pre-identified group of people. These sites reduce demand at Public MPODs, support business continuity for critical infrastructure, and provide an alternative method for dispensing to those with disabilities or access and functional needs.*
 - A worksheet was provided to the College on Wednesday, January 20 to complete to begin the process of being a Closed MPOD. The goal is to have this worksheet completed and returned to LACDPH within a week.
 - Serving as a Closed MPOD will require a MOU between the College and LACDPH.
 - A Board agenda item has been prepared for the next meeting.
- Student Health is finalizing the baseline medical staffing requirements and availability. This will also finalize our minimum throughput per hour. Event Services will assist with determining and staffing non-licensed positions.
 - The Tech & Health Division is working to determine how we incorporate our Allied Health students. Clinical Hours and paid positions are being evaluated.
- Feedback from Billie Lyons, Nursing Program Director, indicated that opt out rates of health care workers are significant. Potentially high opt out rates may have implications on the number of vaccines requested from the County.
 - The suggestion of survey of employees was proposed and is being investigated.
