

Federal Relief Package: What higher ed leaders need to know January 8, 2021

Here is some good reading on the new HEERF funding from NASFAA. [NASFAA | American Council on Education, Association for Public & Land-Grant Universities Estimate New HEERF Allocations](#). Allocations use the following formula.

- 37.5% on FTE enrollment of Pell Grant recipients who were not enrolled exclusively in distance education courses prior to the qualifying emergency
- 37.5% on headcount enrollment of Pell Grant recipients who were not enrolled exclusively in distance education courses prior to the qualifying emergency
- 11.5% on FTE enrollment of non-Pell Grant recipients who were not enrolled exclusively in distance education courses prior to the qualifying emergency
- 11.5% on headcount enrollment of non-Pell Grant recipients who were not enrolled exclusively in distance education courses prior to the qualifying emergency;
- 1% based on FTE enrollment of Pell Grant recipients who were exclusively enrolled in distance education course prior to the qualifying emergency
- 1% based on headcount of Pell Grant recipients who were exclusively enrolled in distance education courses prior to the qualifying emergency
