## Grants Update for the 4th Quarter of FY 2019-20

## New Applications/Allocations:

- 1. Institute of Museum and Library Services CARES Act Grants for Museums and Libraries
  - The request is \$353,887 over a two-year project period.
  - This project would use a variety of approaches to address the barriers students
    encounter in accessing their learning materials. Approaches will include adoption
    of open educational resources, library purchases of e-textbooks when possible,
    increased use of course reserves when campus reopens, and promotion and
    development of a campus awareness of issues surrounding the topic of
    textbooks and how to address them.
- 2. California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office Nursing Education Program Support
  - The request is \$262,448 over a one-year project period.
  - This annual allocation, which varies from year to year, is meant to expand the
    nursing program's enrollment capacity, to provide diagnostic assessment of and
    to develop individualized remediation plans for pre-nursing students, to provide
    a retention program of support services and intensive case management for
    nursing students, to prepare nursing students for the national licensure exam,
    and to provide nursing faculty with professional development to enhance
    teaching, learning, and student support.

## **Upcoming Applications:**

- 1. National Science Foundation Inclusion Across the Nation of Communities of Learners of Underrepresented Discoverers in Engineering and Science (INCLUDES), Planning Grant
  - Cal Poly Pomona is the lead on this planning grant application.
  - The application will request up to \$100,000 over a one-year period, with Mt. SAC potentially receiving \$35,000 of the grant funds.
  - The planning grant would enable civil engineering faculty members from both institutions to plan for the development of an INCLUDES implementation grant application, which would request approximately \$2.5 million over a five-year period. This project would focus on the planning and design of programs that assist engineering students in completing their undergraduate education.
- 2. LA84 Foundation Track & Field and Cross Country Youth Instructional Program
  - The application is a two-phase process, with the first phase due in mid-July and the final application due in late August.
  - We are working with the LA84 Foundation to determine an appropriate budget amount, which will likely be at least \$200,000 for a one-year project.
  - The project would re-institute the long-standing LA84/Mt. SAC Relays Youth Days event, which went on hiatus during stadium construction. The year-long program

would also include track & field instructional clinics for K-8 students during the winter, cross country instructional clinics for middle school students during the fall, a culminating cross country event for middle school students in October, and coaches' clinics (both in-person and online) throughout the year. We will have contingency plans in case we are unable to hold events due to COVID-19.

- 3. National Science Foundation Improving Undergraduate STEM Education, Hispanic-Serving Institutions (IUSE, HSI)
  - Cal Poly Pomona is the lead on this application.
  - The proposed project, titled "BRIDGE: Bridges Institutions to Determine Gaps in Engineering Education," is currently going through Cal Poly Pomona's internal review process. If accepted, the full proposal will be due in September.
  - If funded, Mt. SAC would receive \$40,000 over a three-year period.
  - The objectives of this proposed project are:
    - To better prepare/increase student success of prospective community college transfer students by developing a pathway program, a summer bridge program, and a first-year experience course and
    - ii. To identify academic/social factors and challenges for transfer students seeking to complete bachelor's degrees by identifying critical success factors from a survey of transfer students.
