

Basic Fire Academy - Operational Clear Span Structure in Lot M - Success! Wednesday, December 2, 2020

Below are photos from Ray Mosack that show the Clear Span Structure we rented for use by the Basic Fire Academy in Lot M.

As Ray says, this is probably the safest in-person class on campus and has been a great success!

This is a 25 meter wide x 30 meter long x 4 meter high structure (approx. 82 feet x 98 feet x 13 feet)

- Students (cadets) are in 4 groups (companies) of 10 with the groups separated by 15 feet on one side and 20 feet on the other. There is a distance of 9 feet between students in the groups.
- It solves the problems of both sun and rain.
- Furniture and equipment is stored in the two adjacent conex boxes (containers) when class is not in session for security reasons.
