Discussion on Future Early College Academy/Programs:

- Hacienda La Puente USD: Workman Early College Academy Network (WECAN) has been hosting virtual informational meetings. All interested 8th grade students who are seeking acceptance to WECAN for the upcoming 2022-2023 school year may begin applying now. The application deadline for the academy is Monday, February 28, 2022.
- Bassett USD: Bassett high school will start implementing the dual enrollment program starting summer 2022 at their current comprehensive high school. The dual enrollment team is working with Bassett high school and the district to provide informational sessions to students, parents, and the community.
- Pomona USD: Ganesha high school will start implementing a dual enrollment program starting summer 2022 at their current comprehensive high schools. Monica Principe, Director of Curriculum & Instruction Secondary, continues to have discussion with her Superintendent and Board in regards to opening up an Early College Academy.
- Partners: Dual Enrollment is meeting with high school partners and districts to increase
 access to college level courses and expand dual enrollment opportunities at every
 partnering school site.

<u>Dual Enrollment Counselors:</u> Lina Soto and Rudy Santacruz continue attending high school discussion meetings for curriculum planning. Rudy assisted in developing a handout on the benefits of obtaining an Associate Degree for transfer for Mt. SAC Early College Academy of West Covina.
