
- Open Doors is an annual report of international students studying in the U.S. and abroad conducted by the Institute of International Education (IIE)


Open Doors Report 2021 (IIE)



STUDENT EXCHANGE VISITOR PROGRAM (SEVP) UPDATES

- **March 2020 COVID-19 policy guidance still in effect through AY 2021-22:**
 - Continuing students may count online/hybrid courses towards full course of study
 - Continuing students may take all online courses from abroad while maintaining F-1
 - New or Initial F-1 students not enrolled as of March 9, 2020 are not permitted to have all online courses
 - AY 2022-23 policy guidance is to be determined by late spring 2022
- SEVP Field Representative met with the ISP on January 20, 2022
- **Mt. SAC SEVP Recertification approved through November 26, 2023!**

DEPARTMENT OF STATE

- Embassies/consulates struggling with visa interview backlog
- Scaling back the “intent to depart” policy to make the visa process more reasonable and equitable for student applicants
- Visa interview waivers for citizens of countries part of the Visa Waiver Program

LewerMark Student Insurance

- New F-1 student health insurance vendor as of Summer/Fall 2021
- Completed first payment to LewerMark
 - **246** students were invoiced for Fall 2021
 - **10** students were granted insurance waivers
 - **7** were outside the U.S. | **3** had acceptable alternative insurance
- LewerMark continues to be very helpful, participatory, and cooperative
- Current term ends July 31, 2022


LewerMark: Scholastic Emergency Services (SES)




FALL ENROLLMENT DATA

Fall Admission Yield (%)




SPRING ENROLLMENT DATA

Applications Received, Admitted, & Enrolled




SPRING ENROLLMENT DATA






International Recruitment: Keystone Academic Solutions

- Keystone Academic Solutions (Keystone) is a digital recruiting service
 - Mt. SAC is promoted and detailed on over 400 websites around the world in over 30 languages
 - **Lead-Generation:** When students are interested in Mt. SAC, they are able to streamline communication with our International Admissions team
 - **SmartHub:** Platform that allows us to track communications, review metrics, and create and follow up with student leads
 - **Workflow:** Once a lead is generated, students receive automatic email notifications until they submit an application.
 - **Connections:** Prospective students, via Workflow, can request a phone, video, or chat session with our International Admissions Team

 - Keystone Recruit package added for 2022 – Team of people dedicated to creating new leads per month and following up with leads until application submission

Other Recruitment Updates

- **Global Student Mobility (GSM):**

- GSM is a master agency that serves as a conduit between the ISP and international agents around the world.
- We are finalizing an agreement to enter year two. This agreement only requires Mt. SAC to pay a commission when a student completes their first and second semesters

- **Individual Agents and Agencies:**

- ELS opted out and is no longer pursuing any agreement
- We are establishing an agency vetting process to establish relationships with reputable agencies

Other Recruitment Updates

- **MOUs with English Language Schools:**

- These are non-compensatory agreements between Mt. SAC and English language schools
- Agreement allows students at a language school to pass a certain level of ESL and have their Mt. SAC English proficiency requirement waived
- Mt. SAC and the English language school will provide information about each other's program to prospective students and exchange promotional materials
- Mt. SAC will be able to conduct recruitment events at the language school
- This is a common practice among international student programs across the U.S.

Other Recruitment Updates

- **Collaboration with High School Outreach:**

- Reestablished communications between the ISP and HSO to prepare HSO for encounters with F-1 or F-2 students in the districts HSO serve and streamline communication
- The ISP provided HSO with materials to provide during their visits or communication

- **International Travel:**

- International travel is still dubious (e.g. Canada recently cancelled their live fair and converted to virtual and Sweden is on the “do not travel” list by the Department of State)
