Mt. San Antonio College HEERF III (ARP) Emergency Grant

PROPOSED Distribution Plan for 2021-2022 academic Year

OVERVIEW

The Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) is authorized by the American Rescue Plan (ARP), Public Law 117-2, signed into law on March 11, 2021, providing \$39.6 billion in support to institutions of higher education to serve students and ensure learning continues during the COVID-19 pandemic.

MtSAC's HEERF III Student Portion Allocation is \$30,213,091. \$1,446,955 has been distributed via staff referrals and online emergency aid applications. **Remaining balance is \$28,766,136.**

Deadline to distribute these funds to students is **May 2022**. The plan is to distribute these funds to students during the Fall 2021and Spring 2022 terms based on multiple methodologies, recognizing students' needs.

ALLOWABLE USES

Students may use the grants toward:

- o Any component of their cost of attendance
- o Emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as:
 - Tuition
 - Food
 - Housing
 - Health care (including mental)
 - Child care

RECOMMENDED ACTION PLAN

MtSAC will use a graduated hybrid approach in distributing HEERF funds to students (details of each approach detailed below)

- Tiered batch post awards (total \$25,032,050) to students based on the highest documented unmet need determined by the FAFSA or CADAA Financial Aid Application. Used as a tiered methodology. Tier I for students receiving federal or state aid and Tier II for students who have documented need but may not be receiving federal or state aid. This includes Dreamer students.
- Staff Referral Application process (total \$1,050,000)
- Online Emergency Aid Application (total \$2,230,500)
- International Student Awards (total \$ 450,500)

As outlined in the Grant Agreement, Mt. SAC is required to prioritize HEERF III funds to students with the highest need. Students are no longer required to be Federal Title IV eligible.

<u>TIER I BATCH DISTRIBUTION</u> - Pell Grant Eligible Students: Completed the 2021-2022 FAFSA application and have high remaining unmet need based on FAFSA Application and term specific enrollment level.

<u>TIER II BATCH DISTRIBUTION</u> - Non-Pell Grant Eligible Students: Completed the 2021-2022 FAFSA or California Dream Act application (CADAA) with documented financial aid need based on FAFSA/CADAA information and term specific enrollment level. Because of lack of receipt of federal aid, award amounts are \$250 higher.
