Chapter 3 – General Institution

BP 3930 Children Non-Student Minors on Campus

While on the campus of Mt. San Antonio College, non-student minors children under 12 years of age who are not approved for enrollment in special programs or community services must be directly supervised at all times by a responsible adult. Such children shall not be left unattended in College buildings, outdoor areas, or in private automobiles. non student minors are here at the risk of the supervising adult who brings them. Supervising adults are expected to maintain control of their ensure that the minors and ensure they abide by the Standards of Student Conduct at all times while they are on campus. Mt. San Antonio College employees should shall not be expected to supervise unaccompanied minors. or assume the responsibilities of the adult bringing the minor to campus. Non-student minors under the direct supervision of an adult are permitted on college premises under the following conditions:

- a) Attending college events designed for public viewing or participation.
- b) Participating in college-approved events for which adult supervision is provided.
- c) <u>Accompanying adults for non-instructional or college business purposes (e.g. registration, fee payments).</u>
- d) Accompanying adults to instructional activities with the express permission of the instructor or the supervisor of the activity. Minors may not attend instructional activities if the instructor/supervisor does not grant permission (AP 4700 Classroom Visitors and Other Attendees).
