WORKGROUP UPDATES

PIE & Outcomes

Drafted the following common PIE goals that all centers could adopt.

- Equity and Access: Increase academic support services to underrepresented and disproportionately-impacted students to support course and program retention and success.
- Resources and Technological Currency: Maintain resources, current equipment, software, and technology to support students in building, applying, and practicing skills for course and program success.
- Staff and Professional Development: Hire high quality academic support staff and provide them with ongoing opportunities for professional development and technical training, including learning about and implementing practices that support environmental, social, and economic sustainability.
- Marketing and Outreach: Increase the number of students who are utilizing academic support services.

Wrote two recommendations for areas of common assessment.

- DEISAA centered assessment
- Faculty- and staff-centered assessment

Tutor Training

- Will launch two surveys for tutoring community, one for tutoring leadership (coordinators/faculty) and one for tutors, to gather data about current training practices in centers, what support is needed, and what tutors gained from tutor 10A.
- Completing comprehensive CANVAS trainings modules that will replace Tutor 10A course for fall 2023.
- DEISA focused speaker series for the tutoring community will begin in August.








Ethnicity Fall 2022










Unduplicated Students



Lab FTES Comparison by Year




