The College President/CEO shall ensure that the College has a comprehensive, broad-based ongoing planning and evaluation cycle that is driven by the College's Mission, **Vision, Core Values,** and Goals and supported by institutional effectiveness research. This planning process involves appropriate segments units of the College and is inclusive of all constituent groups.

The institution assures the effectiveness of its ongoing planning processes by systematically reviewing, evaluating, and modifying, as appropriate, all parts of the cycle, including institution and other research efforts.

The planning system shall include plans required by law, including, but not limited to,

- Long range <u>E</u>ducational <u>and Facilities</u> <u>M</u>aster <u>P</u>lan, which shall be updated periodically as deemed necessary by the governing board
- Facilities Plan
- Faculty and Staff Diversity Plan Equal Employment Opportunity Plan
- Student Equity Plan
- Matriculation
- Transfer Center
- Cooperative Work Experience
- EOPS Extended Opportunity Program and Services

The College President/CEO shall submit those plans for which Board approval is required by Title 5 to the Board.

The College President/CEO shall inform the Board about the status of planning and the various plans and seek Board input during their development.
