One CCCApply Updates: Dual Enrollment Process

- 1. Secure courses, Identify students, start the enrollment process
- 2. Softdocs Etrieve Packets: Single Sign On
- 3. CCCApply and Clearing: Students answer supplemental questions on the CCCApply application for them to be identified as a CCAP student, Non-CCAP student and/or Special Admit student. Students are assigned a cohort based on the answers. The cohort is not activated until the student is cleared for the correct course and term. The process is being reviewed and evaluated on an ongoing basses with the assistance of the Enterprise Applications Systems Team.
- 4. Data collected will support tracking, reporting, and research efforts pertaining to these students. Until IT programmed it, it was not possible to track CCAP vs. non-CCAP students.

Discussion on Future Early College Academy/Programs:

- Hacienda La Puente USD: Workman Early College Academy Network (WECAN) is still recruiting students for 2023-24 academic year. College credit courses will begin Summer of 2023
- Bassett USD: Bassett high school began their first year of the Early College Program. Bassett
 is currently hosting 3 college credit courses in Fall 2022 and 3 college credit courses in WinterSpring 2023. Fall 2022 courses are currently fully enrolled and students will transition in a
 cohort model for the next term.
- Pomona USD: Ganesha high school began their first year of the Early College Program.
 Ganesha is currently hosting 6 college credit courses in Fall 2022 and 7 college credit courses in Winter-Spring 2023. Fall 2022 courses are currently fully enrolled and students will transition in a cohort model for the next term.

Dual Enrollment Counselors:

Counseling continues to be an essential partner to the success of the dual enrollment program. Counselors are connecting with our instructors, students, and high school partners. Dual Enrollment will be working with counselors to set-up presentations for partners, parents, and students. Counselors have also set up a Canvas shell for students to obtain college information and resources. Counseling is also setting up an ESARS link that will allow the dual enrollment counselors to set counseling appointments for students.
