1. INTRODUCTION

Purpose: This certification form enables a California Community College to identify their plans as to whether or not they will establish and support a Mathematics, Engineering, Science Achievement (MESA) program.

ACTION REQUESTED:

Complete and submit the 2022-23 Community College MESA Program Certification form in Alchemer by Friday, November 4, 2022.

Background:

In 1999, the Legislature included a little over \$2 million in ongoing funds in the annual state budget for colleges to implement a Mathematics, Engineering, Science Achievement (MESA) program. This program is designed to provide academic and support services for economically and educationally disadvantaged students majoring in calculus-based STEM fields who seek to transfer to a four-year institution. This legislation requires that funding be used for community college faculty, staff, business leaders, students, and four-year colleges and universities to work collaboratively to support economically and educationally disadvantaged students.

California FY 2022-23 Budget Act:

Enables all colleges to elect to establish and support California Community College Mathematics, Engineering, Science Achievement (MESA) programs. Funds provided in the Budget Act for MESA programs shall enhance California's STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) workforce, while aiding the state and nation in reducing equity and achievement gaps.
