

President's Cabinet Action Notes March 5, 2024

- 1. Cabinet reviewed and commented on the following standing items:
 - a. Marketing and Public Affairs provided the following updates to Cabinet:
 - The LAist (89.3) reporter covered the Parent Institute event and met with Dani Silva. She has proposed a few additional stories about Mt. SAC programs and services to the editor.
 - A CalMatters reporter has contacted Mt. SAC regarding a story about financial aid and application/enrollment fraud and fraud prevention efforts.
 - The Annual Magazine is being printed and will be shared at the end of the month.
 - The Community College League of California will be hosting an interactive webinar about SB895. This proposed bill would enable the piloting of nursing baccalaureate degrees at 15 California community college districts.
 - Recent community activity: ribbon cutting at Pomona Valley Hospital Medical Center Pediatric Unit, where they commented on the quality of nursing students from Mt. SAC. Upcoming events: La Verne chamber mixer; ribbon cutting event for a youth softball field in San Dimas; a City of Industry State of the City event; and an Irwindale Chamber luncheon featuring Hilda Solis.
 - Marketing provided an update regarding the replacement of the mascot. The vendor who is creating the mascot designs, Street Characters, will create two versions for the campus to vote.
