

## President's Cabinet Action Notes February 25, 2025

- 1. Cabinet reviewed and commented on the following standing items:
  - a. Marketing and Public Affairs provided the following updates:
    - Marketing's proposal for a presentation on the mascot makeover was approved and they will be presenting at CCPRO to other California community colleges.
    - Marketing is finalizing their billboard placements.
    - Digital ads began being advertised after the first day of Spring.
