Counseling services are an essential part of the educational mission of the College <u>and are available for all students</u>. The College President/CEO shall assure the provision of counseling services, including academic, career, and personal counseling, that is related to the student's education.

Counseling shall be provided for all first-time students enrolled for more than six units, students enrolled provisionally, and students on academic or progress probation.
