Project Description  What need will the project address? What activities will be implemented?	According to the California Economic Development Department, in LA County, the occupation of nursing assistant is expected to grow by 13.5% from 2020 to 2030, an increase of 4,240 jobs. This project will enable SCE's CNA program to hire additional instructional assistants, purchase student supply kits, pay students' certification exam fees, and offer scholarships to offset programmatic costs (e.g., physical exams; background check; tuberculosis test; Mt. SAC student ID card; CPR card; parking permit; textbook; uniforms).				
Expected Outcomes  What are the project's expected benefits/outcomes?	The CNA program offers up to four cohorts annually. This grant funding provides additional academic support for students to improve their course success rates, prepare them for the certification exam, and improve their certification pass rates. Additionally, students' financial barriers are addressed through the availability of scholarships and payment of certification exam fees. This support increases the number of students taking and pass the exam.

SAC has successfully applied for funding annually for nearly a decade.
