

President's Cabinet Action Notes **May 26, 2026**

1. Cabinet reviewed and commented on the following standing items:
 - a. Cabinet approved the [Request to Fill Log](#) for the following positions:
 - [Director, Distance Learning, and Instructional Technology](#)
 - [Professor, Counseling](#) (Position #3)
 - b. Cabinet approved the following Emergency Funding Requests
 - [Instructional Service Agreements and program cost funding](#) for Dual Enrollment in the amount of \$40,000, as a one-time expenditure
2. Cabinet discussed topics for the upcoming Quarterly Management Staff Meeting, which is scheduled on Thursday, June 4, 2026.
3. David provided an update to Cabinet related to [AB 727](#), which requires higher education institutions that issue student identification cards to include the Trevor Project's LGBTQ+ suicide hotline to be printed on the ID card. This mandate will be added to the current Education Code Section 215.5 language that requires higher education institutions to print suicide prevention hotline telephone numbers on ID cards.
4. A request has been received by UCLA to add additional cameras to the Mt. SAC cadaver labs. The new cameras will be placed at the entrances to the labs. The estimated cost for these additional cameras is expected to be approximately \$6,000. The cost will be covered through instructional equipment or lottery funds. Cabinet approved this request.
5. Cabinet discussed the recent Mt. SAC Fire Academy Program Accreditation Report. The report identifies both short-term and long-term requirements for the training site. These improvements are necessary to meet the health, safety, and State Fire Training standards. Cabinet committed the resources needed for 1) portable restroom facilities; 2) handwashing stations; 3) a protective tent structure; and 4) adequate water supply to support compliant fire training evolutions.
