1. Cabinet reviewed and commented on the following standing items:

2. Adrienne Price joined Cabinet for discussion of the Title III Strengthening Institutions Program Grant. This upcoming grant is for 5 years with a maximum request of \$3M. There are four different [competitive preference priorities](#), one of which is artificial intelligence. Our approach is to focus on AI as the priority and infuse workforce readiness where possible. This grant proposal is building on the AI work of AAC&U, guidance from Education and Technology Committee, Academic Senate, and the Library AI literacy group. Cabinet supported moving forward with the submission of this grant and thanked Adrienne for her dedicated work.
3. Melba provided an update on the 2026 Commencement Ceremony, which is scheduled for Friday, June 12, 2026. Thus far, there are 1,446 graduates registered to participate in Commencement. We are looking forward to celebrating our amazing students!
4. Joe and Rosa provided a draft of the 2026-27 Tentative Budget that will be presented to the Board for their consideration of approval at the June 24, 2026, Board Meeting.
