

President's Cabinet Action Notes August 12, 2025

- 1. Cabinet reviewed and commented on the following standing items:
 - a. Marketing and Public Affairs provided the following updates:
 - Marketing will begin a campaign, "Rizzly's Random Acts of Kindness," beginning the first week of the Fall semester, recognizing employees and students for being kind.
 - Marketing is engaging in a campaign to contact students who have completed a portion of the application process but have not enrolled in courses.
 - A colleague at LA Metro reached out and requested that a student participate in the LA Metro celebration commemorating the opening of the A-line connecting Mt. SAC and Cal Poly.
 - Congresswoman Norma Torres is hosting a manufacturing tour event to discuss workforce development and the expansion of manufacturing in the Inland Empire.
- 2. Cabinet continued the review of the Institutional Memberships list for the 2025-26 budget year.
- 3. Cabinet reviewed updates from the Dual Enrollment program, including a co-teaching model that includes a faculty liaison. Implementation of this model will be discussed with appropriate faculty leaders.
- 4. Joe provided updates on the various campus beautification projects happening on campus in preparation for the Fall semester. The Administrative Services teams are reviewing quotes from contractors and completing assessments on asphalt repairs, exterior lighting on the art building, additional wall-mounted lighting, tree trimming for enhanced lighting, and emergency blue phone assessment.
