# Summer Bridge 2025: 226 Student Participants



- 560 new student applications
- 385 first-generation students admitted
- 242 attended orientation.
- Students are assigned to teams and linked courses:
  - an academic class,
  - a counseling class,
  - a learning community.



Students who complete the program with a 2.0+ GPA, are CA residents or AB 540 eligible, apply for financial aid, and enroll in at least 6 fall units are eligible to apply for the Promise Plus Program.

**Early Registration:** Only for 1<sup>st</sup> year students (Winter, Spring, Fall)

**Enrollment Status:** 82% Full-Time, 18% Part-time

**Program Benefits Disbursements:** \$534,879 for the following

- Book Grants
- Mandatory Fess Reimbursements
- Campus Dining cards
- Free Parking Permits

**Additional benefits distributed:**

- School supplies for all participating students
- Backpacks for 1<sup>st</sup> year students
- Promise Plus Program hoodies for 2<sup>nd</sup> Year students
- 44 Loaned Calculators for Stats C1000

**Spring 2026 Participation:** Fall students must see a counselor, attend a workshop, and keep a minimum 2.0 GPA to continue in the program to receive benefits
