

President's Cabinet Action Notes September 16, 2025

- 1. Cabinet reviewed and commented on the following standing items:
 - a. Cabinet received the following diversity, equity, inclusion, social justice, anti-racism, and accessibility updates:
 - The School of Continuing Education's Intergenerational Art Show is scheduled for this week at the Walnut Senior Center.
 - In collaboration with the LA County Department of Public Health, there is a new *free* vending machine that includes Covid-19 tests, overdose prevention items, and sexual health products. This machine is located outside the north entrance of the Student Center.
- 2. Adrienne Price presented the following Grant Proposal Approval Summary Form:
 - Second Nature, Catalyst Grant The grant application was approved to be submitted.
- 3. Cabinet reviewed an email from the Chancellor's Office regarding the launch of the <u>Regional Professional Development Networks</u>. The networks advance the work of faculty professional learning in alignment with Vision 2030. Mt. SAC has a strong professional development program on campus; therefore, it was determined not to participate in this program at this time.
- 4. The School of Continuing Education has been collaborating with Los Angeles County in relation to their new facilities agreement. The agreement is under review, and if unable to find a compromise, it may affect access for some students. SCE has been working with the city of La Puente to utilize alternate facilities.
