Hello, the following was determined and voted at our Regional Consortium Steering Committee meeting today:

- Mt. SAC should continue to represent our Regional Consortium jointly with a K-12 point person. [Rocky Bettar \(Rowland\) and I will be the points of contact for our consortium. We'll be responsible for completing the Governance template.](#)
- Voting should retain the current agreement of "one vote per member institution". [Retained.](#)
- MOE funds should be directed to each K-12 and there should be a separate single fiscal agent for Consortia funds. [All districts will receive their MOE funds directly. The Steering Committee decided to delay until the next meeting \(Sept 3\) a decision on Consortia funds oversight. Members need time to process the information and consult with their districts. Along with 4 of our K-12 partners, I'll be attending the state AEBG summit and we also agreed to submit a presentation proposal.](#)
