

## Were spaces available in placement-appropriate Math and English classes for First-Time Students on their appointment date?

First-time students who completed Orientation, Assessment and Education Planning were assigned to the 'NRETP001' (new and returning priority 1) group. This does not include first-time students who are in special populations (such as EOPS, Connect 4, Bridge, etc.) The NRETP001 group was able to register on 7/22/14 beginning at 4:00 pm (day 7). There are 897 students assigned to the NRETP001 group. Of these, 190 registered on or before their assigned date and 523 registered after their assigned date. 184 did not register (as of 8/26/14). This is based on the SFR0048-A report in Argos:

### 1. What Math and English classes were available on 7/22/14?

The Decision Support System tracks nightly fill rates for every class in the schedule. Here is a summary of the available seats in Math and English at the start of the day on 7/22/14 and the end of the day 7/22/14.

Highlighted courses were effectively full and closed to new enrollments.

2. What classes did students in the NRETP001 group enroll into?

3. What classes did students in the NRETP001 group waitlist into?

Waitlists are a rough indicator of demand. In order to be placed on a waitlist for a course, the student must meet the prerequisite for that course. If a student is on the waitlist for the course, it could indicate a preference for time or instructor as opposed to an indication that no sections of the course are available.

Conclusion – ENGL 8 A, MATH 110H, MATH 160, MATH 51A, MATH 61, MATH 71A and MATH 71X were unavailable to First-Time Students (even with priority). Given the waitlist activity, ENGL 1A, ENGL 67, ENGL 68, MATH 130, MATH 50 and MATH 51 all had demand that was unmet by the schedule even though space may have been available. Students may have avoided registering into remaining available sections due to instruction format (on-line), timing, or special requirement (such as being part of a learning communities cohort).
