

Intervention Writing Team

Meeting Summary

May 1, 2014

The Student Equity *Intervention Writing Team* met for the first time May 1st. The 20 members span existing intervention strategies and programs, including representatives from "Support Interventions", such as online orientation, probation support, assessment preparation and early alert, "Learning Interventions", such as tutoring, supplemental instruction, and late night study areas, and "Textbook Availability", including book store expansion, emergency book fund, library reserve, and online resources. The team reviewed the purpose and goals of Student Equity, the *Student Support (Re)defined* document and the Mt SAC local structures developed to identify and address student equity needs.

Once oriented, the team committed to using the action research cycle to identify the problem, develop a plan of action, collect data, analyze data and form conclusions, modify the theory and repeat the cycle, and report results. The outcome will be a robust examination of existing interventions and plans to meet student needs in new and innovative ways.

At the next meeting, all members will bring data already collected about their programs and begin the process of analysis and gap analysis. The work group is meeting every two weeks; the next meeting is Thursday, May 15 at 2:30 in 4-2440. Please feel free to join the team.
