Pathways to Transfer 2014 Preliminary Results

I am sending the data that we got from our first year of the Pathways Winter/Spring 2014, which was compiled by Maria Tsai in the Research Office. The success data from the English is not as spectacular as the math, but we are especially impressed with the data from the second chart, the progression rate comparisons, which we will continue to compare as the semesters progress. Creating pathways definitely improves the possibility of students getting through basic skills sequences.

I shared this today at Flex Day, to general population attendees in the first session and to the current Pathways faculty in the second. We don't have success and retention data from summer 2014 yet, but I will send it when I get it.
