Subject: Art Model Hourly Increase

Attached is a comparison of hourly rates paid to art models working at educational institutions in our surrounding area. Currently art models at Mt. SAC are paid \$21 per hour. This falls well below the average rate of \$24.53 paid across all schools listed in the comparison, with the most common rate being \$25 per hour (see attached).

Art models are an integral component of our Fine Art and Animation programs. As our hourly rate becomes less competitive, models who have been loyal employees of Mt. SAC for years are opting to take work assignments at institutions that are closer to their homes and pay more.

For Mt. SAC to be consistent with local institutions and retain our current art model workforce, we request the following:

- the hourly rate for models move to \$25 per hour.
- an increase of \$ 2,600 to meet the need for the remainder of 2014-15, with an annual increase of \$4,500 beginning in 2015-16.
