# Mt. SAC Student Services Dual Enrollment Proposal

#### Focus

To enable first generation, basic skills level high school students to experience first-hand and prepare for college while still in high school.

### Goal

Enable local high school students to enter Mt. SAC prepared for college and to be "college ready."

#### **Process**

## 11<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Fall: Assess students in the 11<sup>th</sup> grade to enable college and high school staff to review results and plan for interventions. Students can be in a Basic Skills Strand for ELA or Math or a College Level Strand. Courses are planned based on students' level of assessment and high school course enrollment. Interested students enroll in Counseling 57 (.5 unit)
  - o Suggest Basic Skills students start with reading regardless of ELA or Math
  - Suggest College Level Strand take Mt. SAC courses to meet high school requirements of US History (11<sup>th</sup> grade) and American Government (12<sup>th</sup> Grade).
- Spring: Offer READ 80 and or READ 90 based on students' level or a STDY course
- Summer: Provide either Counseling 1 or Reading or ALEKs Math workshop in special summer program courses all held at the high school.

# 12<sup>th</sup> Grade

- Fall: Students enroll in high school math in their 12<sup>th</sup> grade year. Math enrollment dependent on students' level of high school math. ELA strand begin English pattern in ENGL 67 or 68.
- Spring: ELA continue ENGL pattern; Math continue math pattern
- Summer: Students do not need Summer Bridge, but participate in a different transition program by completing English/Speech pattern, taking Counseling 1
