- 1. Labor Market Information (LMI): the regional consortia chairs and we, COE directors (statewide) are working on defining a framework to gather and present LMI in the grant applications. The goal here is to agree on what data to consider and what methodology to use, in order to be consistent statewide, and make sure we compare apples to apples. We have a call next Tuesday 8/19 from 10 am to noon to discuss it. I'll keep you updated.
- 2. LAOCRC is hosting 2 summits on 9/9 and 9/10 for DSNs and CTE Deans to meet and discuss what they propose to do with the funds. As soon as we define the LMI that will be used in the grant applications, I will start preparing data for the priority and emerging sectors.
