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<h2 style="text-align: center;">Maintenance Work</h2> <p>Per Public Contract Code (PCC) §20651 and Board Policy 6340-Competitive Bidding, Quotations and Contracts</p> <p>Repairs, including maintenance as defined in PCC §20656, that are not a public project as defined in subdivision (c) of Section 22002.</p> <p>Maintenance Definition (PCC §20656):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Routine, recurring, and usual work for the preservation, protection and keeping of any publicly owned or publicly operated facility for its intended purposes in a safe and continually usable condition for which it was designed, improved, constructed, altered or repaired. 		<h2 style="text-align: center;">Public Works</h2> <p>Per the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (CUPCCAA), PCC §22002(c) and Informal Bidding Procedures</p> <p>Public Works Definition (PCC §22002(c)):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Any construction, reconstruction, erection, alteration, renovation, improvement, demolition, and repair work involving any publicly owned, leased, or operated facility, any public structure, building, road or other public improvement of any kind. 2. Painting or repainting of any publicly owned, leased, or operated facility. <p>Note: Informal bidding procedures does not apply to purchases of equipment and/or supplies. For maintenance work, the District follows PCC §20651 and not informal bidding procedures as allowed under PCC §22003. *Amounts subject to changes/ increases.</p>

Advertisement: Send Notice (via mail, fax or email) of Inviting Bids to all contractors for the category of work to be bid from the District's current contractors list per PCC §22037 this shall be done no less than 14 calendar days before bids are due. Emergency Projects – Field Agreement for Services	<p><\$75,000</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum 1 quote solicitation • Contractor <u>is required</u> to be registered with DIR and submit Certified Payroll to DIR • Contractor <u>is required</u> to provide insurance (COI) with endorsements • Must pay prevailing wages over \$1K • Bonds <u>are required over \$25K</u>: Bid Bond; Payment and Performance bond • District is required to submit project to DIR for DIR Project ID (and send Project ID to contractor) • Must pay Prevailing Wages • Request insurance claim via Risk Management • Ask Accounting for funding source
