### **Simulated Performance**

The ARRT requirements specify that certain general patient care procedures may be simulated if demonstration on patients is not feasible. Simulations must meet the following criteria:

- The student must competently demonstrate skills as similar as circumstances permit to the cognitive (comprehension), psychomotor (bodily function), and affective (emotional) skills required for performing the procedures on patients;
- The clinical instructor & program director must be confident that the skills required to competently perform the simulated task will generalize or transfer to the clinical setting, and, if applicable, the student must evaluate related images.
- The student's opportunity to simulate a procedure will be left up the professional discretion of the clinical instructor.
