Mandatory Rehearsal—

Participation in Commencement Rehearsal is mandatory. Rehearsal is held on the morning of Commencement, June 10, on the grassy area south of the stadium. The rehearsal will last from 9:30 to 11:00 a.m. No kids/guests/pets allowed. Dress casually



When & Where to Arrive—Graduates should arrive with their caps and gowns at the back of the stadium next to Bldg. 50G by 5:45 p.m. on June 10 for assembly and final processional instructions. Lot F is designated parking for graduates and guests.

Guest Admission & Arrival—The commencement ceremony is open to all guests of the graduates—*no admission tickets are necessary*. Family members and guests should be encouraged to arrive early, as there may be delays with typical Friday peak-hour traffic. Also the prime parking areas and Stadium seating fill up fast. **Stadium gates open at 5:00 p.m.**

Disabilities/Special Needs—Students and their guests who need additional assistance (mobility, sign language interpretation, etc.) must contact Disabled Student Programs & Services at (909) 274-4290 no later than Monday, June 6 to request needed accommodations. Guests are responsible for attending to the personal needs of other family members.

Decorum—Throughout the formal portions of the ceremony, students are asked to maintain appropriate decorum befitting the dignity of a college commencement. Grads will have ample opportunity to celebrate and "strut their stuff" during the awarding of diplomas, as their families cheer them on. No decorations that will obstruct the view of people behind you. No Selfie Sticks Allowed. No outside food or ice chests allowed. Refreshments available for purchase.

eligibility & mandatory petition process

All candidates **must** file an **Application for Graduation** with the Admissions & Records Office by **Friday, May 13** to guarantee their names in the be printed in the commencement program. Applications will be reviewed to determine eligibility, so long as all documents and transcripts are submitted. Candidates will be notified by mail whether their applications are approved or denied. We do not have a separate commencement application.

Eligibility—Students who have applied for graduation with the Admissions and Records Office are eligible to participate in the commencement ceremony. There is no additional application for the ceremony. The following degree seeking students are welcomed to participate in the ceremony: "Fall 2015 and Winter 2016" Degree Recipients & "Spring 2016 & Summer 2016" degree candidates.

other important info

Name Verification—In order to ensure the correct spelling of your name in the commencement program and on your diploma, you are advised to check the accuracy in your student portal.

Diplomas—Actual diplomas are not issued at the commencement ceremony—only the diploma covers. Grads will receive official diplomas by mail approximately **12 weeks** after the end of their graduating term. *Please make sure that your address is correct on your portal.*

Diplomas Held—Please note that if you have an outstanding obligation to the college, this will prevent us from releasing your diploma when it becomes available.

- Scholastic Honors: cumulative GPA of 3.90-3.99 in all college coursework

- Phi Theta Kappa: International honor society
- Mt. SAC Honors Program Scholar: Recognizing students who complete 15 or more Honors units with at least a cumulative GPA of 3.2.



where topark

Students and their guests may park in Lots F, H and S. Faculty and staff may park in a reserved section in the south end of Lot R near the Stadium and Student Lot 50G. The walk from Lots F and H to the Stadium is a considerable distance. Guests should use the underground tunnel located in the southeast corner of Lot F and not attempt to cross Temple Avenue. For those who have a Disabled Persons (DP) license plate or placards, parking is available at the north end of Lot R, adjacent to the stadium. A tram will stop at Lot R for those guests requiring mobility assistance.
