

In an effort to better serve faculty needs, the School of Continuing Education conducted a Professional Development Survey of their noncredit faculty. 37 faculty responded to the survey and various themes were identified as areas of interest/need for further professional development. The top three areas identified were: Effective Teaching Practices with 65.7% interest, Infusion of Technology into Teaching & Student Retention Strategies tied at 42.9% interest and Accessibility issues and online classes came in third with 40% interest. This information will assist the Professional Development Council's work towards meeting goal #4, "Assess and evaluate needs for the professional development of faculty."
