

Call for Internship Applications
Los Angeles County Arboretum & Botanic Garden
Summer Session is May 26 to August 5, 2026

The Los Angeles County Arboretum & Botanic Garden is now accepting applications for 4 paid internships in amenity horticulture. The remuneration for the 10-week course is \$18.00/hr. You will be exposed to nearly all aspects of botanical garden operations. The horticultural component will emphasize the following: perennials, roses, orchids, greenhouse management, nursery management, plant propagation, plant collections curation, fruit tree care and specific techniques relating to proper pruning, planting, weeding, watering, fertilizing, plant identification, vegetable gardening, integrated pest management, soil science, and sustainability.
