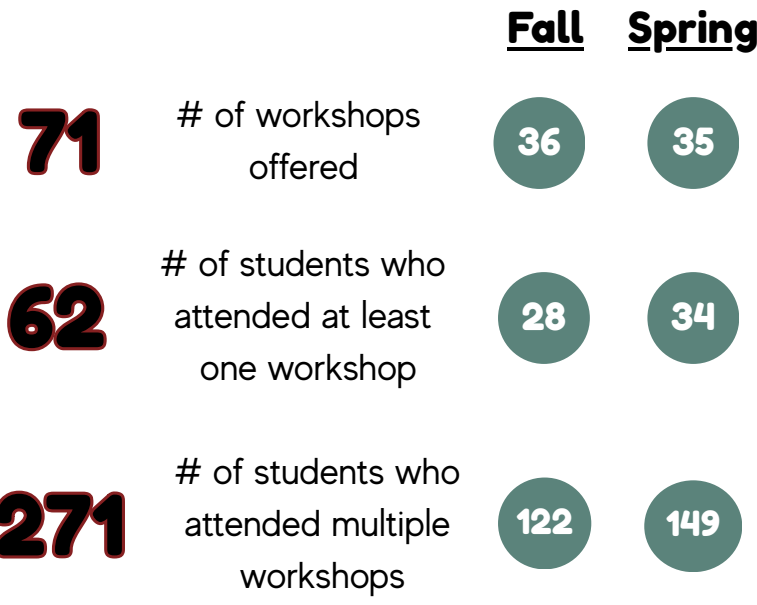


# LEAD PROGRAM

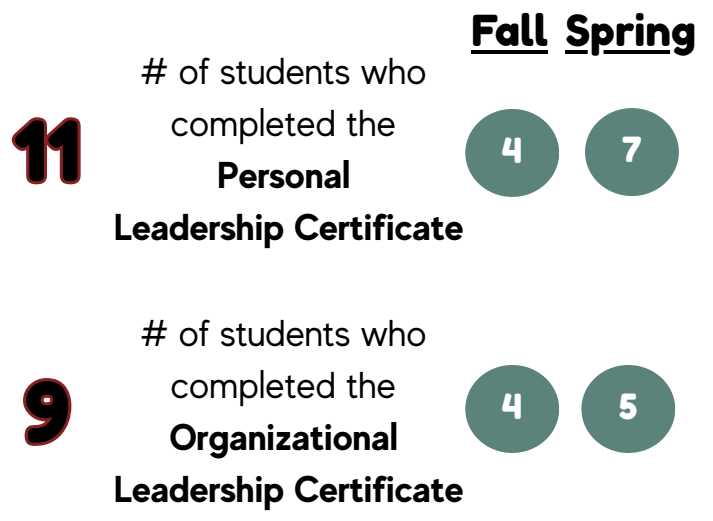
## Fall 2025 & Spring 2026
