These events include: rock climbing, bocce ball, basketball, yoga, baseball, soccer, golf, swimming, martial arts, dance, goal ball, skateboarding, and kayaking. In addition, all attendees and volunteers will receive one free meal pass for either breakfast or lunch through the requested \$6500.00. All in all, by having the attendees engaging alongside volunteers, the overall community can stand in solidarity in promoting disability athletics to secure longevity in life and health. For volunteers, an invaluable experience is achieved through cultivating friendships and evaluating the perspective of attendees to promote disability awareness for our community.
