Whereas: The accountability system for 'Ask a Mountie Booth' in the Organizational Directive is both outdated and unrelated to the current event known as "Mountie Pride Monday".

Whereas: The requirement for the change of the name of the event, clarity and simplification for completing hours and making up missed hours is necessary for the Organizational Directive.

Whereas: Associated Students requires an updated system that will set a clear minimum hours for A.S Officers to complete for each Mountie Pride Monday event to end the confusion over how many hours must be completed per event.

Whereas: A new and simple description of the event 'Mountie Pride Monday' is needed to simplify questions that A.S Officers and student representatives may have and needs to be represented in the Organizational Directive.

SENATOR JOB DESCRIPTIONS

All A.S. SENATORS shall:

- 1) Attend all A.S. Senate meetings in accordance to the A.S. Attendance Policy
- 2) Arrange a minimum of two (2) office hours each week to conduct A.S. business. ~~including a minimum of one hour biweekly at the "Ask a Mountie" booth. "Ask a Mountie" hours must be tracked through the Student Center Specialist so that no more than two A.S. officers are at the booth at the same time. Each session must be a minimum of one (1) hour to minimize time lost while setting up.~~
 - *Mountie Pride Monday hours must be tracked through the Activities Senators. Activities Senators must report the record of hours completed for each A.S. officer to the Vice President and Advisors for inspection and review. A minimum of 1.0 hour must be completed for each Mountie Pride Monday event. Any excused absence will be subjected to the present activities absence system stated on line 3.*
- 3) Attend and participate in all A.S. hosted events for a minimum of three hours per event (i.e. in any combination before, during, or after an event). If an A.S. Senator is not able to attend/participate in an A.S. hosted event, s/he must spend three hours promoting the event prior to the start of the event. Hours must be documented by the Publicity Senator. Two absences are allowed per semester and Senators may only publicize an event two times as a means of making up attendance for missing an A.S. hosted event.
- 4) Serve on at least one (1) college-wide committee
- 5) Attend one (1) Board of Trustees meeting each semester
- 6) All A.S. Senators are required to attend two (2) Executive Board meetings each semester
- 7) Submit a completed Work-in-Progress Form in the 6th and 12th week each semester
- 8) Maintain their Senate Binder as per the Senate Binder Guidelines
- 9) Abide by the Student Standards of Conduct and embody the virtues of the A.S. Vision statement

 The Associated Student Body shall elect two Senate Chairs. The Senate Chairs work with the A.S. President and both Vice-Presidents

Both **SENATE CHAIRS (2)** shall:

- Represent the interests of Senate to the Executive Board
- Alternately chair the Senate meeting

To the Associated Students Senate:

On behalf of the Executive Board of Mt. SAC's Associated Students, Bill #2 Mountie Pride Monday Reforms has been vetoed. This bill was pulled for discussion on September 20th following the Senate meeting. We have stipulated our concerns.

The wording of Bill #2 has presented us with cause for concern. It is stated in the revision "A minimum of 1.0 hour must be completed for **each Mountie Pride Monday event.**" In discussion this was meant to relieve some burden off of senators as well as ensure the booth is attended to at all, if not most, times. But the three-hour minimum for each event supersedes this stipulation, still requiring senate members to be present three hours for each event. The wording in Bill #2 does not conglomerate all Mountie Pride Monday Events into one large event as intended.

It is the suggestion of your Executive board that this Bill be reworded to the effect that despite there being multiple days, Mountie Pride Mondays will constitute one event, and each officer will be responsible for a one hour minimum per day. It is also suggested that Senate consider the inclusivity issues that our current make up policy may have.




A minimum of 1.5 hours must be completed for each Mountie Monday event.

Any excused/nonexcused absence will be subject to the present activities absence system stated on line 3.

If an A.S Senator does not meet the 1.5 hour threshold for a Mountie Monday Event, they will be subject to make up hours via the present activities absence system.
