Purpose and Nature of the Club Event

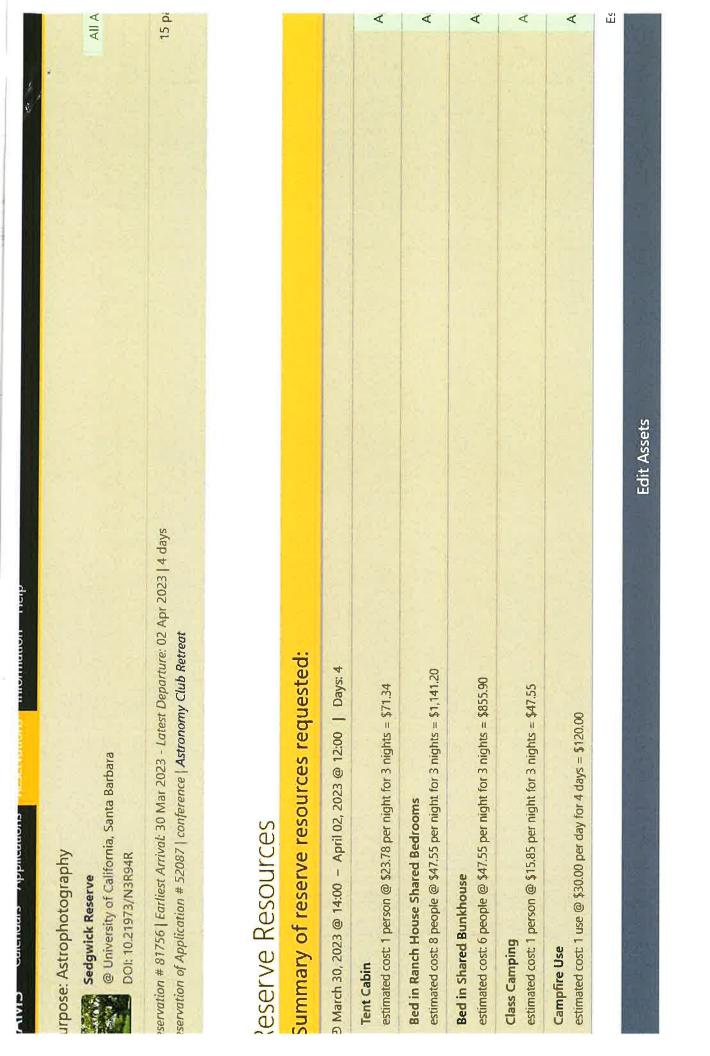
Sedgwick Reserve is located in Santa Ynez, CA. This area of Southern California is known for its dark skies, which are essential for astronomical imaging. The city night sky is filled with light pollution, which makes it difficult for viewing astronomical objects, especially for imaging. The reserve is known for scientific research projects in ecology, geology, meteorology, and astronomy.

The Earth Science & Astronomy department has used Sedgwick Reserve for a field trip location during the ASTR 99 Astrophotography class in the past. Now, we'd like the opportunity to take the Astronomical Society club members to this dark sky place. During the daytime, we'll be able to discuss with the students how to use equipment, best astronomical targets for viewing, and how to process images. During the nighttime, we will have the campus telescopes and other equipment for the students to take images, or just look around the night sky. The students will get a hands-on experience for what it is like to be a field astronomer, and also gain knowledge about the targets they are looking at. Astrophotography isn't just about taking pretty pictures; it involves a lot of time spent researching the target and planning/processing the series of images. Not only will the students be introduced to the equipment, but there will be two advisors present to help guide the students throughout the night.

Sedgwick Reserve is ideal for astronomical imaging because of its dark skies. Since it is farther away than some of our past trips, we are hoping to stay for three nights since we will be traveling over Cesar Chavez weekend. Since it is expected to be cold, our reservation request includes the use of the bunk house and ranch house at the reserve so that the students can warm up if needed. The Astronomical Society is asking for funding assistance from Associated Students for this trip to help cover the cost of the site and meals. We will be requesting the use of campus vans so that there is no additional transportation cost or financial hardship to the student drivers. We are very grateful for the possibility of campus support for this event.
