Agenda item (Bill) would be due 3/14 to make this meeting on 3/19. The Judicial Directive also states that there are 5 student court officers. Changes to this directive can be edited by the court and submitted to Senate. Associated Justices must seek out Senators to write legislation.
 - **Spring Recruitment:** April 8-11 is elections week. The recruitment period is now. Candidate orientations will happen on March 21 or 22 from 12-1pm. Tabling can be done in various areas on the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays (when there are no meetings). Applications will be open the same time as senate positions.
