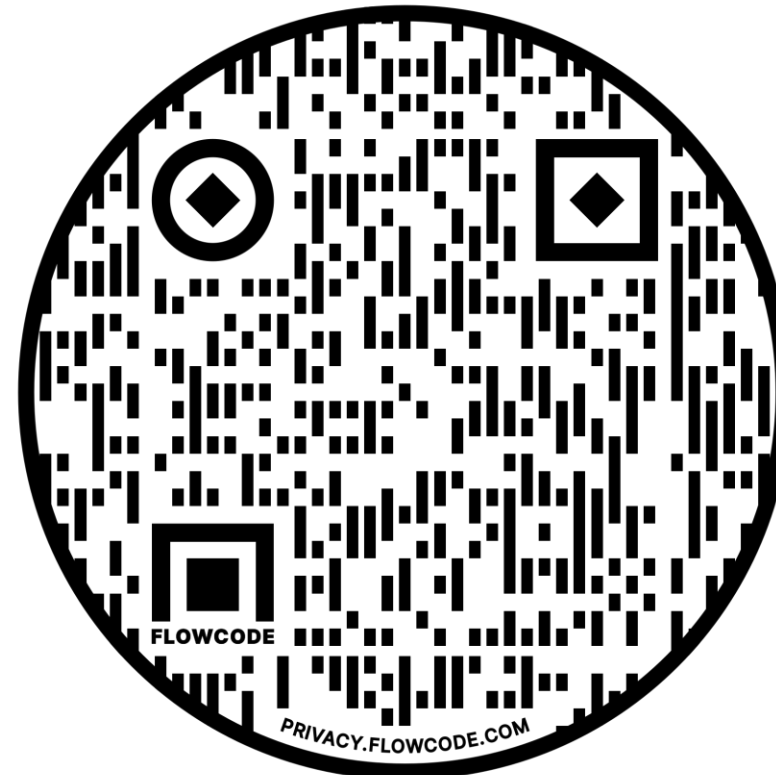

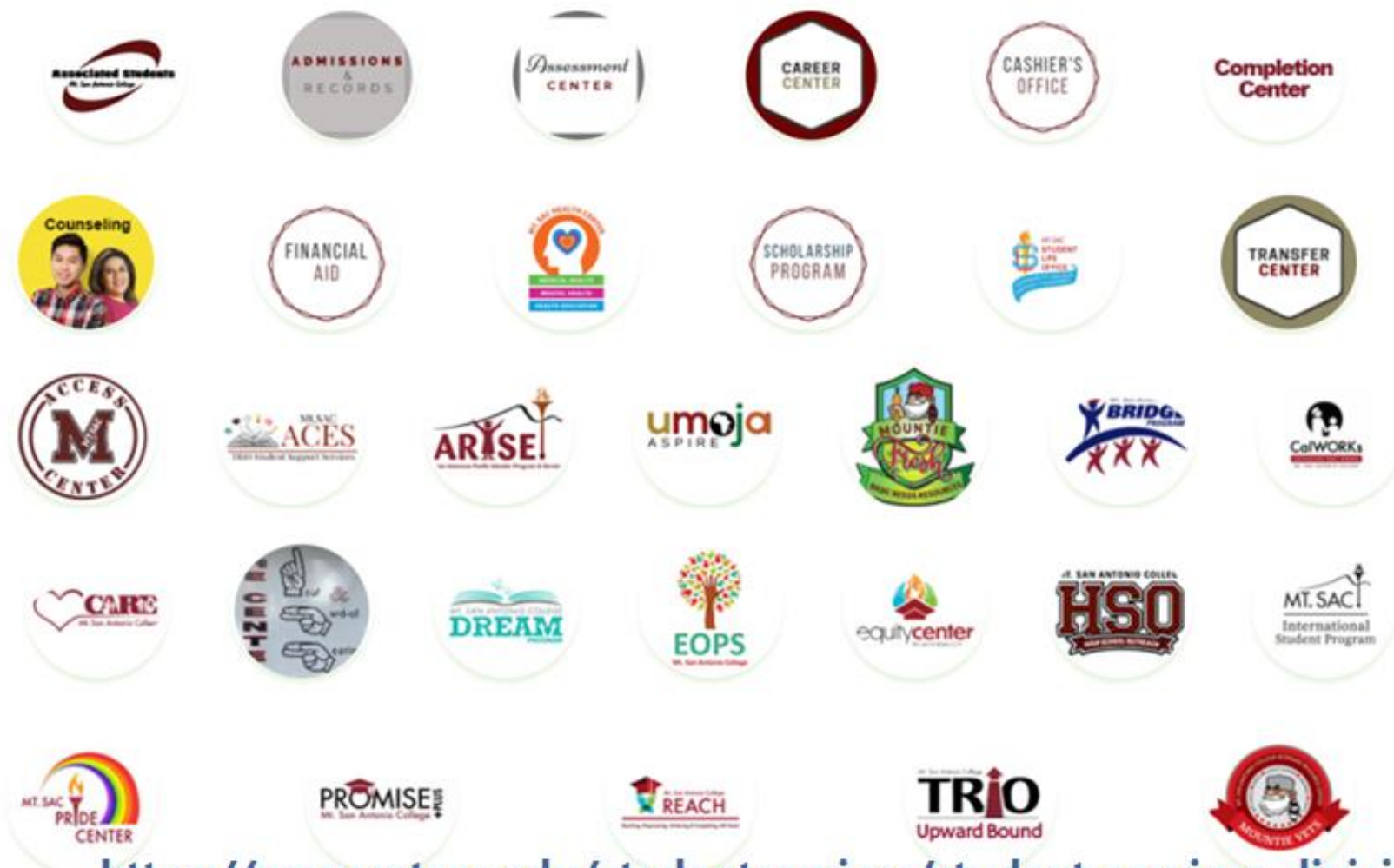
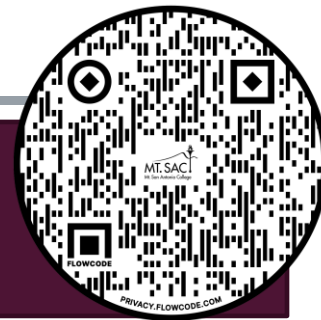

- Bookstore is open **Feb 16-18 from 9-3pm** for Student IDs.







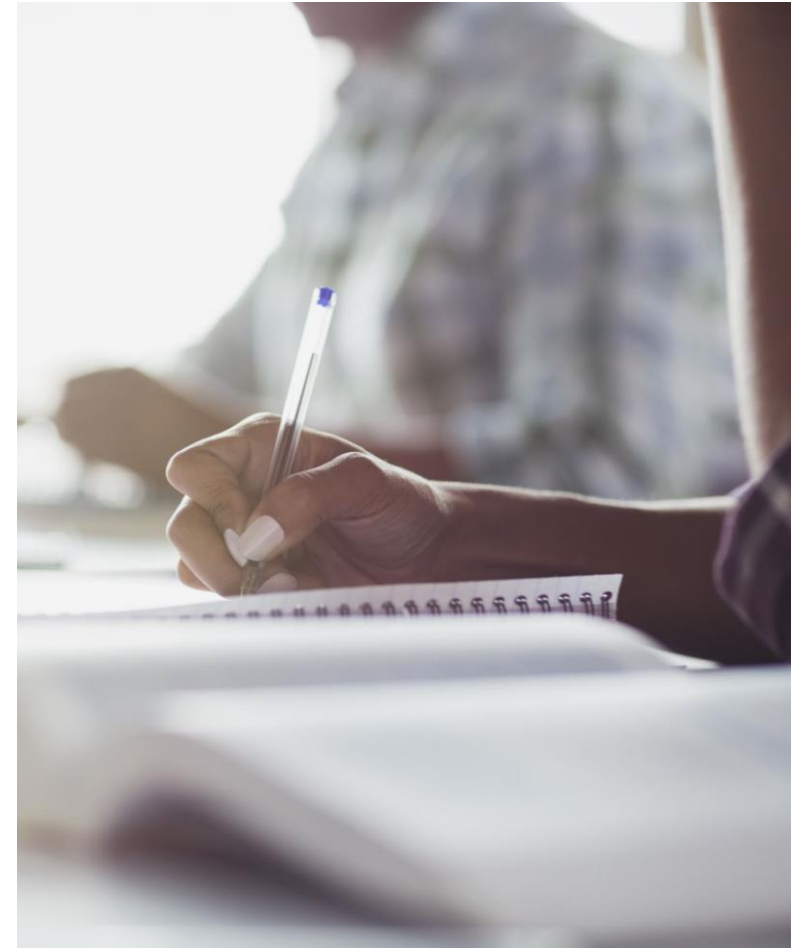
# TEXTBOOK RENTAL RETURN

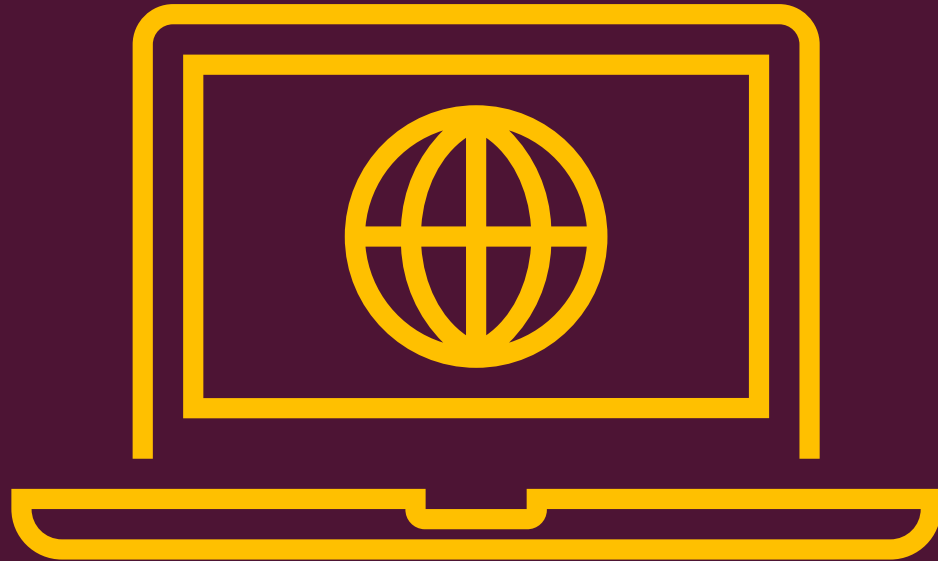

- 1st Day of Spring Semester – **Feb 22<sup>nd</sup>**
- Drop for nonpayment – **Feb 12<sup>th</sup>**
- Winter '21 Pass/No Pass Deadlines For courses that allow P/NP on the Course Outline of Record students can change their grading options from a letter grade to a P/NP. The timeline varies by CRN.
  - Mt. SAC Portal, clicking on the Student tab, and then choosing “#5 Change Class Grading Option.” Students have until 5:00 p.m. on the Thursday after grades are due to make their final selection between a letter grade and P/NP for these courses. For regular 6-week classes, this deadline is **5:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 18.**
- Drop with an EW Deadlines:
  - 6-week classes: The deadline for students to choose an EW is February 7, 2021.
  - Short-term winter classes: The deadline for students to choose an EW is one day before the last day of that specific CRN’s part of term end date

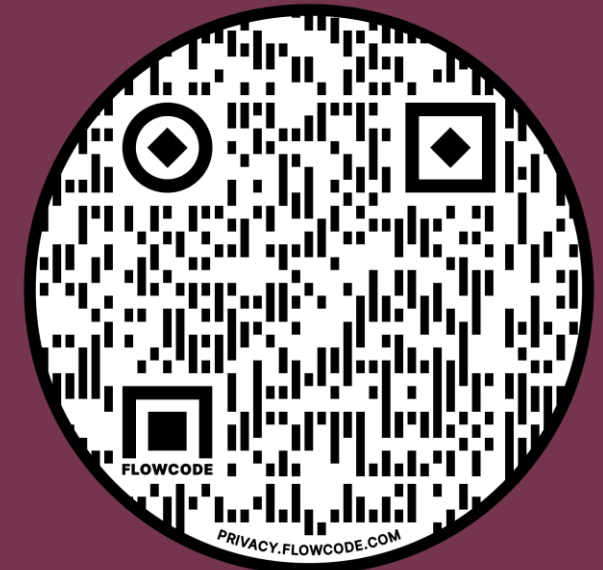



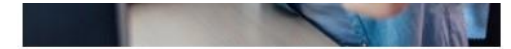
