WHEN IS A CURRICULUM VITAE (CV) MORE APPROPRIATE THAN A RESUME? TYPICALLY, CV IS BETTER FOR ACADEMIA OR RESEARCH PROFESSIONALS

- SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS: PRINCIPALS, SUPERINTENDENTS, DEPARTMENT HEADS
- PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATIONS : LEADERSHIP APPLICATIONS
