To make an appointment, you can visit either of our locations or call (909) 274-4400.***



The Health Center is located at Building 67B on the lower level, across parking lots F & H and north of the pedestrian bridge.





What services do we provide?

- Evaluation and treatment of short-term illnesses and injuries and first aid
- Male & female reproductive health and family planning
- Testing and treatment of sexually transmitted infections
- Personal counseling services and crisis intervention
- Immunizations and Tuberculosis testing
- Chiropractic services
- Access to our health video library and literature
- Health education events and classroom presentations
- Medi-Cal application assistance and referral information

Please visit our webpage for further information. If you are in need of services that we do not offer, we can assist you with community resources. Some providers on our referral lists also offer discounted fees for students.

Who can use our services?

- **Students** enrolled in and currently attending credit classes.
- **Adjunct faculty** currently employed and teaching, are eligible for medical and nursing services only.
- **Employees** are eligible to receive services between hire and termination dates only, as funded by the District such as routinely-scheduled tuberculosis (TB) testing.
- **Non-credit students** and **visitors** are not provided care.

How much does it cost to use our services?

- Doctor, nurse practitioner, counselor, and chiropractic visits are FREE!!!
- Minimal fees are charged for lab and TB tests, immunizations, and medications.

Is there anything else I should know about your services?

Here are a few things to know:

- In order to receive services, you must present your Mt. SAC Banner ID. **Your first Mt. SAC Banner ID is FREE through the Bursar's Office!**
- Scheduling your **first visit** with a counselor or chiropractor must be done in person.
- You are advised to bring approximately \$30 **CASH** for any lab tests, prescription medications, and other miscellaneous services. **We accept CASH ONLY!**
- Arrive 15 minutes prior to your appointment to check-in and complete paperwork.
- Please do not bring children to your appointment.
- Allow adequate time for your visit (approximately 30 minutes to one hour). **DO NOT park in parking spaces with a time limit.**
- We do not release any confidential patient information via telephone or email.
- A fee will be charged if you:
 - arrive more than 5 minutes late to your appointment
 - fail to show for your appointment
 - cancel on the same day as your appointment.
