



## Transitions and Words That Show Logical Relationships

### Words that show *location*:

above	behind	by	near	throughout
across	below	down	off	to the right (or left)
against	beneath	in back of	on top of	under

### Words used to show *time*:

### Words used to *compare* two things:

### Words used to *contrast* two things:

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### Words that *conclude* or *summarize*:
